

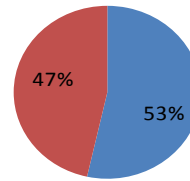
# 2017 Gender Pay Gap Report for Drimbawn (UK) Limited

■ Males ■ Females



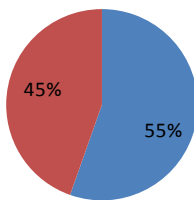

The proportion of Males/Females in each quartile Pay Band is as follows:

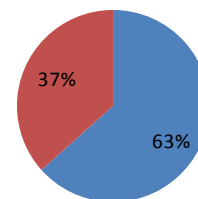
### Lower Quartile

■ Male ■ Female



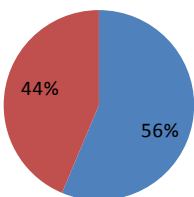
### Lower Middle Quartile

■ Male ■ Female



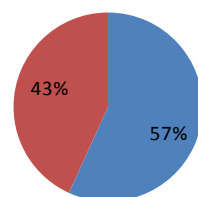
### Upper Middle Quartile

- 7.4% of males and 5.0% of females receive a bonus
