Role Overview

The Intake Supervisor will be responsible for overseeing all grading within the intake area while provide hands-on supervision to safeguard maximisation of product care. In addition the Intake Supervisor must ensure all product is counted on arrival to site and all own collection vehicles paperwork is collated and filed properly.

Main Duties

- Responsible for ensuring that there is adequate equipment and protective clothing within the Intake area
- Ensuring that all mechanical / electrical items meet the required standard
- Ensuring that the staff in intake are trained in order to do stock checks responsibly and accurately
- Ensuring that all staff are grading the product correctly
- Responsible for promoting and implementing quality standards and driving continuous improvement and integrity within the Intake function
- Maintain Health, Safety and Hygiene standards in accordance with Company rules and regulations
- Check yields and stocks on completion of shift, amend if necessary and report any changes to Production Manager
